	Uncrossable features use the standard sprint map symbols and include: high fences, garden beds mapped olive green (out of bounds). Picnic tables in the schools are not mapped. Other man-made objects are depicted by usual black cross. Crossing of the watercourse is prohibited.
Arena:	The arena is in the Tennis Courts and within the Main Hall at the college and is adjacent to the finish and parking area.
Registration:	Available in the Main Hall. Registration only required for competitors picking up sportident cards for hire.
Parking:	Park within the sealed parking area south of the tennis courts adjacent to the dental clinic. You may also park alongside the access road to the car park area and to the east of the registration area. PARKING ON THE GRASSED AREAS IS PROHIBITED AS ARE THE CARPARKS IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO THE DENTAL CLINIC. Please follow the directions of the parking team and observe cones.
Start:	The start is immediately outside of the southern exit of the Main Hall.
Warm-Up:	Competitors can warm up on the tennis courts or on the grassed area.
Toilets:	Public toilets are located in the Main Hall.



Registration Opens:	from 9.30am
Start Times:	No allocated start times – self-start between 10.00am - 11.00am at one minute intervals. LAST STARTS STRICTLY AT 11.00am
Course Closure:	11.30am (all controls are to be collected and moved to Brayshaw Park)
Map Flip:	Long and Middle Red Courses have a map flip. The course on the first side of the map will end at a control (say #5). When you reach that control, turn the map over and the course markings will commence at the same control (say #5). There is no triangle on the second side.
Course Notes:	All maps are printed on A4 waterproof paper.



	Uncrossable features use the standard sprint map symbols and include: high fences, garden beds and areas of vintage farm equipment all mapped olive green (out of bounds).
Arena:	The arena is signposted from the parking area. It is a small park suitable for viewing racers. Please note that some runners may pass through the area between the parking and the arena.
Registration:	Registration only required for competitors picking up hire sportident cards.
Parking:	Park within the sealed parking area. You may also park along the western side of Arthur Baker Place.
Start:	Chasing Start based on the morning result. Likely starting order will be:
	 White & Yellow start at 4pm with mass start at 4:10pm
	 Orange start at 4:20pm with mass start at 4:30pm
	 Short Red at 4:40pm with mass start at 4:50pm

	There are numerous vintage farm machinery scattered around the site. Please show caution. These areas are mapped as areas of out of bounds rather than individual man-made objects. Do not cut between rows of machinery.
	The train tracks for the small-gauge vintage trains are mapped with the Railway symbol 509.1. The miniature train track is mapped with the Tramway symbol 509.2.
	You are free to wander around the Heritage Park once you have competed your course and spectate racers on later courses.
